1. Congregation members as well as school families will have the opportunity to purchase dinner/theater tickets at a cost of \$20.00 per seat. Sales will be capped at 150 tickets, and dinner will be served in the gym prior to the performance. Tickets will go on sale Sunday, January 29, during coffee hour, and will also be available during the week through the school office.
2. Silent auction items are being solicited. Each school classroom will be assembling themed baskets which will be auctioned off.
3. School families and congregation members are asked to consider making donations also. These may include services, such as plumbing, painting, electrical work, gardening, babysitting, window washing, tax preparation, legal services, instrumental lessons. Tangible items could include automotive supplies, audio/visual items, tickets to sporting events, movies, theaters, gift cards to retail stores or restaurants, and homemade one-of-a-kind craft items or artwork. 4. The important donation of time and effort will also contribute greatly to the success of this event.
